

Eye of the Wind has a tried and tested formula for winter sun escapes. Following the old trade wind routes you would expect for a square-rigger that likes to sail as much as possible.




If you want an example of sail power, Oosterschelde is the real thing. A 'National Historic Monument' in the Netherlands, she is the only remaining working example of a large fleet of fast schooners that carried cargoes at the beginning of the last century.

Featured Boat: Outdoor Girl

LENGTH OVERALL: 6m (20ft)

YEAR BUILT: 2008

VESSEL TYPE/RIG: Spritsail Yawl


"The trip up and down Percuil River and back and fore across Carrick Roads has done my mental health a power of good!"

Outdoor Girl is a spritsail yawl that was designed for inshore crab fishing. Navigate the shallows; beach the boat to step ashore or row right into small Cornish harbours. Follow old sea routes up wooded creeks and far into the shallow salt marsh. Anchor in forgotten pools and camp on beaches and shorelines inaccessible by land.

Tuck into places that only smugglers would find. Wild camp, improve your small boat skills and gain the confidence to explore without an engine.

YEAR BUILT: 1895

VESSEL TYPE/RIG: Gaff Ketch

Pilgrim was in 1895, by J W & A Uphams, one of Brixham's most famous yards. Pilgrim was one of six similar vessels built at the yard during that year, adding to Brixham's fleet of over 300 Sailing Trawlers. Today only a handful of these wooden sailing trawlers have survived.


